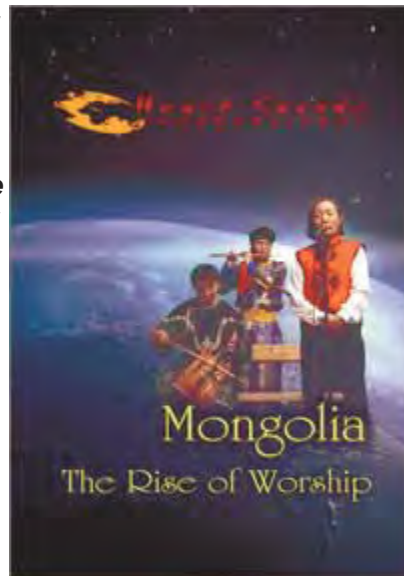

A young and vibrant church has been birthed there and a new generation of Christians is worshiping from the heart using Mongolia's diverse and unique musical forms. In this DVD, ***Mongolia: The Rise of Worship***, you see and hear their story as they express the joy and difficulty of their journey. You also hear the sounds, both new and historic, that are coming from the Mongolian heart. In addition, the DVD shows how the following components of this project work together for long-term impact: 1) songwriting workshop; 2) public concert; 3) audio and video recordings; 4) distribution; 5) local music research; 6) intercessory prayer. The DVD includes a full 31-minute documentary as well as a six-minute version.

months ahead! You can subscribe to the channel and be notified as new videos are added.

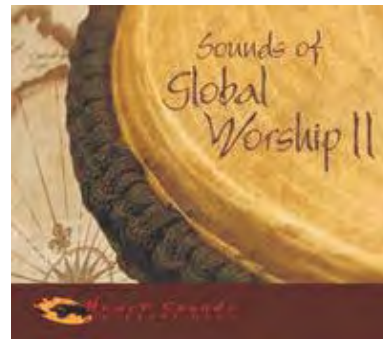
HSI on the lecture circuit

Robin Harris, HSI executive assistant, delivered a paper at the annual meeting of the Society for Ethnomusicology (SEM) on the music of the Sakha people of Siberia. She also took the opportunity to introduce 24 Christian delegates at SEM to the [International Council of Ethnodoxologists](#) (ICE), a global network that she co-founded with HSI leader Paul Neeley. Robin then joined her husband Bill, our HSI administrator, for lectures at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary (Louisville, KY), speaking on global worship.



Sounds of Global Worship CD featured

HSI's latest compilation CD (with 22 tracks from 16 regions of the world) received a very positive review by Greg Scheer, one of the educators at the Calvin Institute of Christian Worship. Greg writes,



“The CD's liner notes speak of the recording as a musical banquet. Indeed. Listening to the smorgasbord of songs on the CD brings to mind the words of the Psalmist: ‘My soul is satisfied as with a rich feast, and my mouth praises you with joyful lips...’ Among the music styles that we encounter are throat-singing from Mongolia, ululation from South Africa, call and response from Ethiopia, and polyrhythms from the Congo. Each of these is a unique gift that is laid at the feet of Jesus.”
