## Living Water in the Gobi Desert

### The Mongolian Gobi Desert



During the ten year history of Heart Sounds International, Mongolia has been central to our ministry. Various recordings, both audio and video have resulted over several visits there. This includes contemporary, folk and traditional styles, as well as a six-part documentary showcasing the various HSI ministries that have developed. From the

start, the vision has gone beyond the Outer Mongolian nation to also include the huge numbers of Inner Mongolians residing in China who face much restriction as believers. The doors opened recently to go to the parched Gobi Desert straddling Outer and Inner Mongolia for the latest Mongolia project.



Heart Sounds International has very recently had the privilege of working with a ministry just two-and-a-half years old that has already planted a church of 100 people, a discipleship training Center, four Outer Mongolian house churches and four more house churches in Inner Mongolia across the border in China. In October, an HSI team conducted a songwriting workshop and recording project for both Inner Mongolian as well as Outer Mongolian musicians from the training center. It was safer to gather across the border (inside Mongolia) than within China.



HSI's team of eleven came from various nations. None of the young students gathered for the songwriting workshop had composed a song before and doubted they could do so. Just three and a half days later, four songwriting teams birthed several new songs and premiered them at two new song concerts. The recording of the new songs then began in earnest. Two team members

were participants from former HSI projects in the capital city of Ulaanbaatar who added traditional instruments and throat singing to the recordings. When polished, these new songs will be combined with previously composed Mongolian composed songs to complete a CD that will be disseminated to congregations in both Inner and Outer Mongolia.



In a dry and parched region, living waters gushed forth during our visit-- a remarkable demonstration of God's outpouring on His people in this part of the world.
